
Standardised mortality ratios [SMRs] for deaths of persons aged under 85 years, 1999-2003, in electoral wards around Ironbridge Power Station, Shropshire, UK



Notes:

- 1. SMR = (Observed deaths/Expected Deaths) x 100
- 2. All data supplied by Office of National Statistics [ONS]
- $3.\,\text{SMR} = 100$ is average for England & Wales, so wards with SMR higher than 100 have higher premature death rate than average; e.g. Ironbridge Gorge, where SMR = 149
- 4. Age standardised mortality rates [ASMR] are a more accurate parameter, but have been declared "not available" by ONS despite their use by Primary Care Trusts. The ASMR for Ironbridge Gorge for deaths of all ages 1999-2003 is 1340.7, which is the highest by far in Telford & Wrekin and more than double the rate for England & Wales of 598.8
- 5. The elevated SMRs in wards downwind of Ironbridge Power Station [prevailing winds predominantly WSW and NW] suggest that PM2.5s from that station are the major cause of illness and premature deaths, as found in studies detailed in "Death, Disease and Dirty Power" [www. cleartheair.org] and elsewhere.
